

# Multivalent aminosaccharide-based gold nanoparticles as narrow-spectrum antibiotics *in vivo*

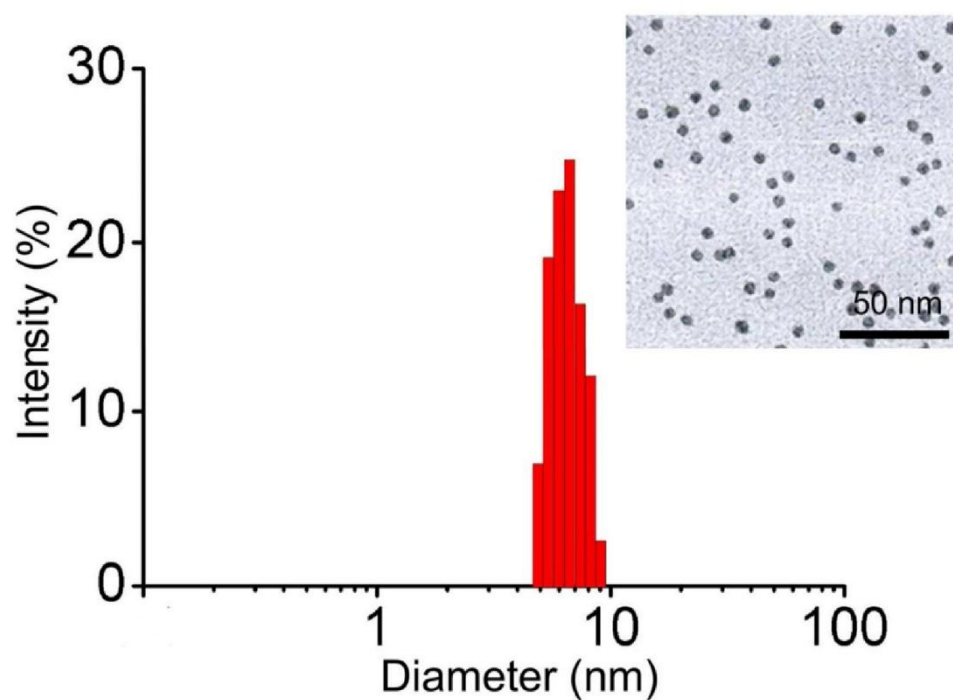
