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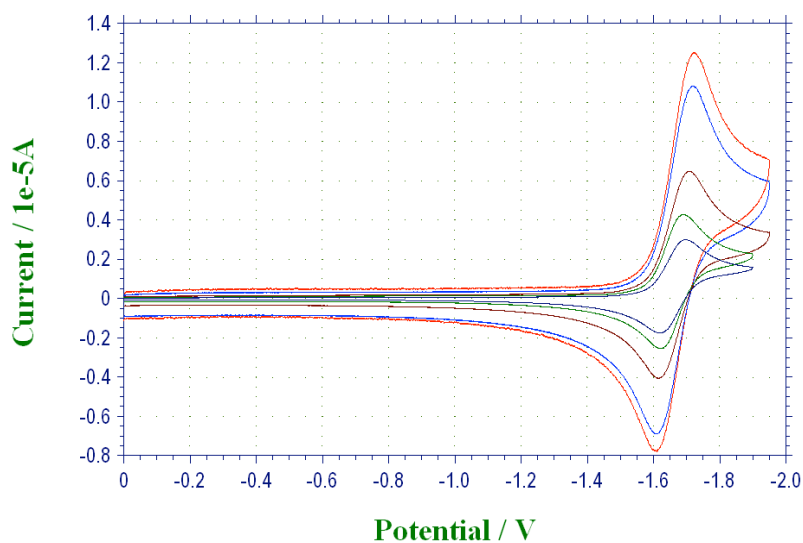


Figure S1. Cyclic voltammograms of **TAM1** for several scan rates (50, 100, 500, 750, 1000) mV/s.

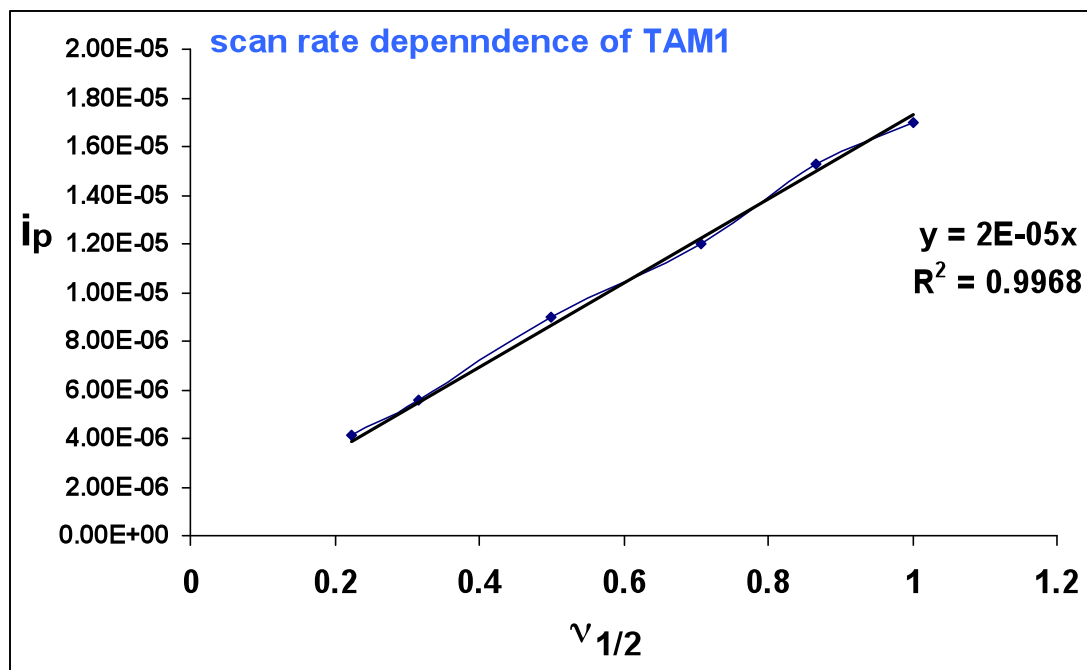


Figure S2. Scan rate dependence of TAM1.

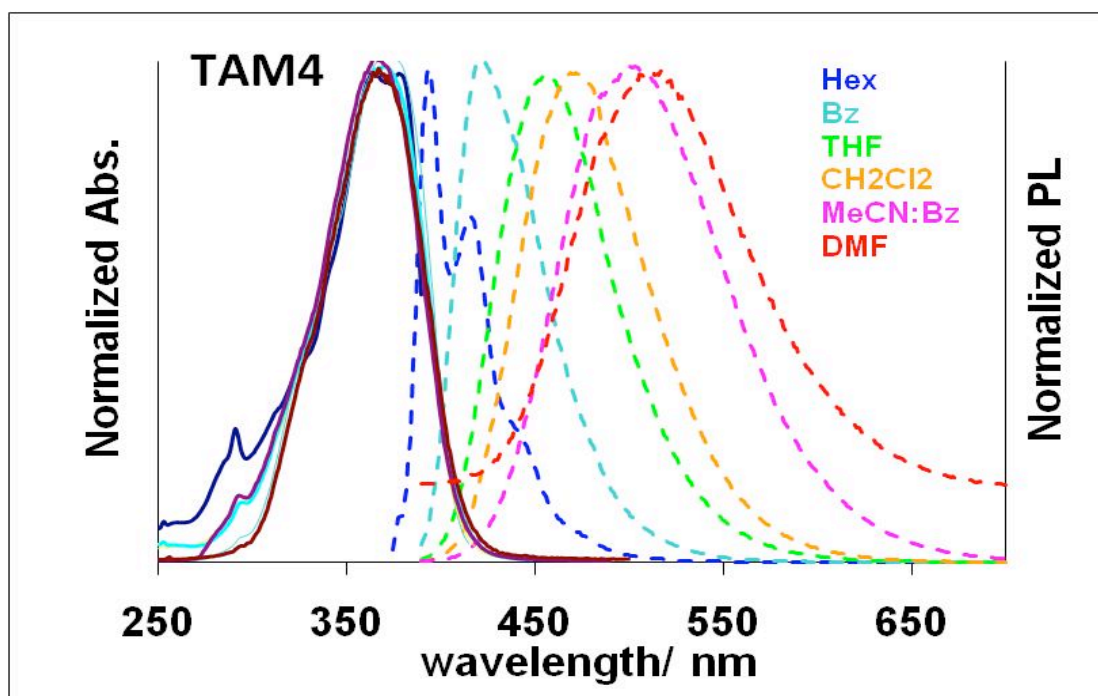


Figure S3. Absorption and emission spectra of TAM4 in different solvents,
